



CATCH a Serial Offender Program

The CATCH Program gives warfighters and others who experienced sexual assault an opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information to help the Department identify serial offenders.

Visit a Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC) or a SAPR Victim Advocate (VA) who will:

1. Explain the CATCH Program
2. Give you a password to submit suspect information, if you wish to participate

If your entry “matches” another entry in the CATCH system, you will be contacted by SAPR personnel, not by law enforcement, since your name is not part of an entry.

Law enforcement cannot identify you from the CATCH system.

Your **CATCH** entry is completely **anonymous**

You can always opt out of the CATCH Program, even after you:

- ✓ Submitted an entry
- ✓ Are contacted regarding a match

You are never required to participate in an investigation unless you want to.
